⁴⁴ Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled." ⁴⁵ Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures, ⁴⁶ and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, ⁴⁷ and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. ⁴⁸ You are witnesses of these things. ⁴⁹ And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

Context

Luke 1:1-4

".. that you may have **certainty** concerning the things you have been taught."

"..of the things that have been **accomplished (fulfilled)** among us.."

1. It *was* right for the Christ to suffer, die and rise (v44-46)

Law, Prophets and Psalms = the whole OT

Deut 32:43, Lev 16, Isa 53 → Atonement

2. It *is* right for the gospel to be proclaimed to all nations (v47-49)

Isa 49:6, Amos 9:12
